1. The present petition has been filed raises challenge to the order dated 25.01.2018 passed by learned Principal District Judge, Family Court, Gurugram, vide which Rs. 7,500/- per month has been awarded to the petitioner as maintenance.
2. There is no representation on behalf of the parties in Court today and same was the position on the last date of hearing i.e. 23.07.2025, whereby, the parties had been directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court on 28.07.2025.
3. As per the report received from the Mediator, the parties did not appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre also.
4. Vide order dated 23.04.2018, notice of motion had been issued on the ground that the counsel for the petitioner at the very outset submitted that the matter be referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, to settle their disputes amicably but for the last seven years, the matter is just

being adjourned for exploring a possibility of an amicable settlement which is not progressing.

5. However, there is an order dated 22.10.2021, whereby, during the pendency of the present petition, the parties have been granted the decree of divorce by mutual consent under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act. Apparently, that could be the reason that the parties are not appearing despite being put to notice.

6. In light of the above, the present petition stands dismissed for non-prosecution at this stage with liberty to the petitioner to seek its revival, in case, any cogent cause of action survives.

7. Pending application, if any, shall stand disposed of.
