**SUDHIR SINGH, J. (ORAL)**

Present Writ Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a Writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to allot a plot measuring 10 marlas to the petitioner in Sector 12, Panipat or in any other adjoining sector being oustee.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner would be satisfied, in case, his pending representation/ application

dated 20.03.2025 (Annexure P-13) is considered and decided by respondent No.2, which has not been adverted to by the respondents till date.

3. On the other hand, on advance service of copy of petition, learned counsel for the respondents appear and oppose issuance of notice of motion. They submit that grievance of the petitioner will be looked into by respondent No.2 and it shall take decision either way, on the pending representation/ application dated 20.03.2025 (Annexure P-13) of the petitioner.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek reply by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider the pending representation/ application dated 20.03.2025 (Annexure P-13) of the petitioner and pass an appropriate reasoned order, in accordance with law, at the earliest, preferably within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy/ production of this order.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
