1. Learned counsel for the appellant submitted that the matter has been amicably resolved amongst the parties and that, as such, he may be permitted to withdraw the instant appeal.
2. Learned counsel representing the respondent has not disputed the factum of compromise. He has passed on a copy of demand draft for an amount of Rs.15 lakhs favouring Shri Sehazveer Singh, son of the appellant, which is stated to be part of the agreed amount of Rs.25 lakhs, stated to have been paid by respondent. The copy of demand draft is taken on record.
3. Since both the learned counsel have accepted the factum of compromise, the instant appeal is disposed off having been compromised.
