1. Through the instant writ petition, cast under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for quashing the complaint dated 20.09.2022 (Annexure P-27), as made by the private respondents No.4 and 5, against the petitioners, on the similar allegations as levelled in the earlier complaints, which has been enquired into and found to be false.

2. Reply/written statement dated 02.05.2024, by way of affidavit of Mr. Deepak Bhatia, Sub Divisional Magistrate, Ludhiana (West), Ludhiana, on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 3, filed by the learned State counsel today in the Court. The same is taken on record. Copy whereof, has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners.

3. The written statement (supra), makes it clear that the impugned complaint has already been enquired into, and after the enquiry, it was ordered
