HARKESH MANUJA, J. (Oral)

1. Learned State counsel on instructions from Ms. Japinder Kaur, State Tax Officer submits that in case the petitioner applies online on GST Portal for carrying out necessary correction, the same shall be done on the same day itself. The petitioner may file necessary application/request by tomorrow.
2. In view of the aforesaid undertaking by the respondent(s), learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.
3. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.
4. The respondent shall remain bound by her undertaking extended before this Court. In case of default, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as cost(s) from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
