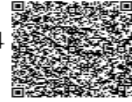
JASGURPREET SINGH PURI J.(Oral)

1. On the last date of hearing i.e.23.01.2025, the following order was passed:-

“Ms. Jyoti Kumari, Advocate has appeared on behalf of the petitioner and has submitted that the arguing counsel is not available today and has prayed for an adjournment.

A perusal of the earlier orders would show that the present petition was filed in the year 2021 and initially for two dates nobody had appeared on behalf of the petitioner and the matter was adjourned and even on the last date of hearing, on the request of the learned counsel for the petitioner the matter was deferred for today. More than three years have elapsed and the matter is still at the preliminary stage and the counsel for the petitioner is still wanting adjournment.

The request of the learned proxy counsel for the petitioner is accepted subject to payment of costs of Rs. 10,000/- which shall be deposited by the petitioner with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Bar Association Lawyers Family Welfare Fund.



Adjourned to 10.07.2025.”

2. As per the report of the Registry, there is no receipt of payment of costs amounting to Rs. 10,000/-.
3. Ms. Lalita Kashyap, Advocate, appearing on behalf of Mr. Namit Khurana, learned counsel for the petitioner, submitted that the aforesaid costs have not been deposited.
