MANISHA BATRA, J. (ORAL)

1. Status report has been filed, as per which the offence under Section 238-C of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, has been added during the course of investigation. On the oral request of learned counsel for the petitioner, the offence under Section 238-C of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, is ordered to be added in the headnote and prayer clause of the petition.
2. Accordingly, Registry is directed to make requisite correction in the headnote as well as prayer clause by adding the aforementioned section.
3. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.86 dated 04.08.2025, registered under Sections 25(1-B) of Arms Act, 1959 of Police Station City Ferozepur Jhirka, District Nuh.



4. Vide order dated 02.09.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner was granted interim bail and was directed to join investigation.

5. Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation on 09.09.2025. The recovery of the weapon of offence has not been effected from him and, as stated in the status report, the same had already been deposited by the petitioner. He is not required for custodial interrogation.

6. Keeping in view the nature of the allegations, pre-trial incarceration of the petitioner is also not required. As such, a case is made out for allowing the present petition. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 02.09.2025, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 (analogous to Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure).
