The petitioner through instant petition is seeking direction to official respondents No.1 to 3 to register an FIR against the private respondents on the basis of enquiry report dated 02.09.2023 (Annexure P-2) conducted by respondent No.4 and legal opinion dated 21.09.2023 (Annexure P-3) given by District Attorney (Legal). It is further prayed that respondents No.1 to 3 be directed to consider representation dated 20.09.2025 (Annexure P-4) filed by petitioner.
2. Notice of motion.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. G.S. Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and assures that respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural), District Amritsar would look into the representation dated 20.09.2025 (Annexure P-4).
4. In view of the above, respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of

Police, Amritsar (Rural), District Amritsar is directed to look into the representation and decide the same in accordance with law. However, direction to decide the representation shall not be construed as a direction to register an FIR. In case, the petitioner is aggrieved, he may be approach the concerned Area Magistrate for getting the FIR registered under the relevant provisions of the BNSS, 2023.
