S. J. VAZIFDAR, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral):

This is an application under Section 11(6) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, read with the Scheme of Appointment of Arbitrators by the Chief Justice of Punjab & Haryana High Court, 2003, for appointment of an Arbitrator.

2. The agreement between the parties is admitted. It is also admitted that the same contains an arbitration clause. Clause 15 of the agreement requires the disputes to be referred to the Chief Administrator of the respondents which is not permissible in view of the amendment to the Act.

3. This application is, therefore, disposed of by appointing Mr. Justice S.D. Anand, former Judge of this Court, as the sole Arbitrator and the fee shall be as per the Chandigarh Arbitration Centre (CAC) (Administrative Cost and Arbitrators' Fees) Rules, 2014. The venue shall be the Chandigarh Arbitration Centre.
