1. This petition has been filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023, seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.62, dated 1.7.2024 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Dehlon, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in terms of the interim directions issued by this Court in connected petition i.e. CRM-M-34359-2024, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

3. Learned State counsel assisted by learned counsel for the complainant and on instructions from ASI Bhupinder Singh informs the



Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation and her custodial interrogation is not required.

4. In view of the statement of learned State counsel, order dated 30.07.2024 is hereby made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS (*erstwhile Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973*).

5. The petition stands disposed of.

6. It is made clear that in case the petitioner is required for further investigation, she may be called or joined the investigation on giving advance notice under Section 160 of Cr.P.C.
