The petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to re-fix the petitioners' pension by granting them annual increment in their last year of retirement.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that at this stage, the petitioners will be satisfied in case they are permitted to make a fresh representation before the respondents raising the grievance as has been raised in this petition, and the same may be ordered to be decided within a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Harish Rathee, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State and submits that in case any such representation is filed by the petitioners, the same will be decided by the concerned respondent, by passing a speaking order thereupon in view of law laid down by this Court vide judgment dated 24.04.2025, passed in

CWP-14627-2024 and other connected cases titled *Mahabir Singh Tanwar v. State of Haryana and others* within three months of receiving the representation.

5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioners has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.

6. Ordered accordingly.

7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioners.
