1. The present petition has been filed alleging violation of order dated 01.06.2018 (Annexure P-1) passed in CWP-15117-2018 titled as 'Harjit Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others', whereby the respondents were directed to consider and decide the legal notice dated 22.03.2018 submitted by the petitioners within a period of 06 weeks from the receipt of certified copy of the order.

2. At the very outset, on instructions from Mr. Shashi Gagg, ARE Legal, Office of Directorate of School Education, Punjab, learned counsel for the respondents has informed that the case of the petitioners has been considered positively and vide order dated 08.09.2025, the Finance Department has recommended the case of the petitioners. Learned counsel further undertakes that the payments due to the petitioners shall be released within a period of 06 weeks from today as, the case has been forwarded to the Accountant General, Punjab.



3. Copy of order dated 08.09.2025, handed over in Court by learned counsel for the respondents is taken on record. A copy thereof, has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the aforesaid undertaking of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may be disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to revive the same in case any cause of action survives or in case, the undertaking given by learned counsel for the respondents is not fulfilled.

5. Heard.

6. In view of the facts noted above, no further direction is required to be passed; and the present petition is hereby **disposed of**, with the aforesaid liberty to the petitioners.

7. Rule stands discharged.

8. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
