After arguing at length, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise all the pleas available to him, before the Trial Court at an appropriate stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty aforesaid.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners contend that the petitioner No.2 is aged about 74 years and is suffering from old age related diseases and may be granted exemption from personal appearance.

At this stage, this Court cannot consider the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners; however, in case, the petitioner No.2 moves any application before the Trial Court, the same shall be considered by the Trial Court sympathetically, keeping in view the old age of the petitioner.

The Trial Court shall also be at liberty to impose any conditions, while allowing any such prayer made by petitioner No.2.
