1. Application under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 read with Section 151 CPC seeking temporary injunction moved by the petitioner i.e. plaintiff before the trial Court in CS-771-2019 was dismissed on 09.08.2022 (Annexure P-5) and that order was upheld by the Appellate Court on 22.09.2023 (Annexure P-6).
2. By way of this revision, the aforesaid orders were challenged. This Court vide order dated 15.01.2024, while issuing notice of motion directed the parties to maintain status quo regarding the suit property.
3. Today, it is informed that both the parties have produced their respective evidence before the trial Court concerned. Even the arguments have already been addressed and the case is fixed for pronouncement the order.
4. In view of the aforesaid latest position brought to the notice of this Court, the present petition is hereby disposed of with the direction to both the parties to maintain status quo, till the suit is decided by the trial Court concerned.
5. It is made clear that trial Court will not be influenced by the status quo order or any other observations made by this Court. The trial Court will make every possible efforts to dispose of the case within one month.
