**JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)**

1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner for setting aside of the order dated 04.07.2024 (Annexure P-7) and with a further prayer to stay the operation of the impugned order.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner was elected as Sarpanch. His election has been cancelled alleging that his matriculate certificate is not genuine. He has preferred an appeal before appellate Authority which is still pending. The respondent is going to conduct election for the vacant seat which has arisen on account of cancellation of the election of the petitioner. He further submits that instant petition may be disposed of in terms of order dated 31.01.2020 passed by this Court in CWP-2685 of 2020.
3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Rajesh Gaur, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State and submits that he has no objection, if instant petition is disposed of in terms of order dated 30.01.2020 passed in the aforesaid petition. He further assures the Court that appellate Authority would decide petitioner's appeal before 15.07.2025.

5. The appeal of the appellant is listed before appellate authority on 08.07.2025.

6. In the wake of statement of both sides and considering the fact that respondent is going to conduct election against the vacant seat, the petition stands disposed of with a direction to appellate authority i.e. respondent No.2 to decide petitioner's appeal on or before 15.07.2025. The petitioner has also filed stay application in the aforesaid appeal. The respondent is going to conduct election on 15.06.2025, thus, it would be in the interest of justice and fitness of things, if appellate authority decide petitioner's stay application before 15.06.2025.
