[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 22.12.2020, in CWP No.22231 of 2020 in case titled as '**Parul versus Uttar Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Limited and another.**'

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that while issuing notice of motion for 07.04.2021, it was directed that in the meantime, till the next date, services of the petitioner be not terminated.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that needful has been done in terms of order (Annexure P-1) dated 22.12.2020 and benefits as per entitlement and salary released to the petitioner, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of

learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
