The order of this Court, the non-compliance of which has been alleged by the petitioner, required the respondent to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order, which has since been done as has been disclosed in the reply. This order is, however, not to the satisfaction of the petitioner.

If that is so, the petitioner would be at liberty to impugn the order so passed by the respondent in the event of his having any surviving grievance against the same.

In so far as the present proceedings are concerned, the rule against the respondent is discharged keeping in view the compliance of the order of this Court.

Petition stands disposed of.
