1. Additional affidavit of Sh. Moneesh Kumar, Director Technical Education and Industrial Training, Punjab on behalf of respondent No.2 has been filed in Court, the same is taken on record.
2. Learned State counsel on instructions submits that arrears of leave encashment have been paid to the petitioners, whereas the arrears qua gratuity shall be credited to them within seven (07) days from today and arrears of pension along with interest shall be released in their favour within four weeks.
3. In view of the aforesaid undertaking by the respondent(s), learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition.
4. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.
5. It is made clear that though the order dated 10.03.2025 with respect to attachment of complete salary of Sh. Moneesh Kumar, Director, Technical Education and Industrial Training, Punjab is hereby modified to the extent that his salary to the extent of 2/3rd shall be restored and 1/3rd shall remain under attachment till the complete disbursal is made to the petitioners. It is further clarified that the moment arrears of gratuity and pension along with interest are released in favour of the petitioners, his salary to the extent of 1/3rd which is under attachment would immediately be restored to him.
