Prayer in this petition is for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent(s) for not complying the order dated 01.02.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-5224-2024 titled as “*Devki Rani vs. State of Haryana and others*” vide which the petition was disposed of with a direction “...to respondent No.3–Commissioner of Police, Sonipat to ensure that the matter arising out of FIR No. 0251, dated 27.7.2023, Police Station Civil Line, Sonipat under Sections 406, 420 IPC is got investigated fairly and expeditiously so that a final report is submitted thereafter at the earliest.”

Learned State counsel has filed compliance report dated 25.07.2025 by way of an affidavit of Mamta Singh, IPS Commissioner of Police, Sonipat. The same is taken on record. He submits that as has been stated in para 10 of the said affidavit, challan has been presented before the Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class,

Sonipat on 01.07.2025 against the accused Suraj Bhan and Ravinder Gautam. It is submitted that completion of investigation has been delayed only due to detailed examination of the financial records and verification of related evidence.
