1. This petition for grant of bail under Section 483 BNSS, has been filed by petitioner, an accused in case bearing FIR No.201 dated 11.06.2023 registered against him at Police Station City Hoshiarpur, for the commission of offences punishable u/s 21, 22, 61, 85 of NDPS Act.
2. At the outset, learned State counsel has intimated this Court that out of 09 prosecution witnesses, 04 witnesses have been examined, 04 have been given up and only one witness remains to be examined.
3. Upon this, learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his prayer to direct the learned trial Court to expeditiously dispose of the trial.
4. Learned State counsel does not oppose the request made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Without advertng to the merits of the present case, considering the fact that the trial is at fag end and only one prosecution witnesses remains to be examined, the instant appeal is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to make earnest efforts to conclude the trial expeditiously in accordance with law, preferably within a period of 03 months from today.
