Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that contempt proceedings be initiated against the respondent(s) for not complying the order dated 30.7.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Division Bench of this Court in CWP-11038 of 2024 titled as “Punjab National Bank vs. State of Haryana and others”, vide which the petition was disposed of on the basis of statement made by learned counsel for the respondents that “...*police protection would be provided as and when sought by the petitioner.*”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite the clear direction of this Court, possession of the property has not been given and even police protection has also not been provided to the petitioner even though two representations dated 11.10.2024



(Annexure P-2) and dated 20.3.2025 (Annexure P-3) have been submitted by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State, on instructions from Mr. Vivek Goyal, Tehsildar, Kalka submits that possession of the property shall be handed over to the petitioner on dated 13.6.2025 positively.

In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the respondent-State, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition be disposed of as not pressed.
