This application has been filed for placing on record relevant annexures i.e. Annexures 5 and 6.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and above said documents i.e. Annexures 5 and 6 are taken on record.

Main case

This petition has been filed for issuance of a writ, order, or direction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of the B.N.S.S., 2023 directing Respondent Nos. 2 and 3

to provide adequate police protection to safeguard the Petitioners' life and personal liberty by considering their representation dated 17.05.2025 (Annexure P-3) and to consider the representation dated 30.04.2025 (Annexure P-1) & 09.05.2025 (Annexure P-2) and take action as per the law against the Respondent No. 5 to 10.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he will be satisfied, in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2-the Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot to decide the representation dated 17.05.2025 (Annexure P-3) and representation dated 25.04.2025 (Annexure P-1) & 09.05.2025 (Annexure P-2) within a time bound manner.

3. Without adverting to the merits of the case, the respondent No.2- the Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 17.05.2025 (Annexure P-3) and representation dated 25.04.2025 (Annexure P-1) & 09.05.2025 (Annexure P-2) after providing opportunity of hearing to them by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. A copy of order so passed be supplied to the petitioner within one week thereafter.

5. Petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
