By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Bharatiya
Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case
FIR (Annexure P-1) as under:

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in compliance to the order dated 08.04.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as such interim bail granted to the petitioner may be confirmed.



3. Learned State counsel, on instructions received from ASI Suresh has intimated that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no more required for any custodial investigation in this case nor she is required for further investigation.

4. Heard.

5. During the course of hearing on 08.04.2025, the following order was passed:-

“2. It is, inter alia, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent having no criminal antecedents and has been falsely implicated in this case. She contends that no specific overt act is attributed to the petitioner nor any injury is attributed to the present petitioner who is a married lady aged about 23 years having no involvement in criminal matter and therefore, seeks concession of anticipatory bail.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Arun Kumar Gujjar, AAG Haryana, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondent and prays for time to file the status report/reply in the matter. Learned State counsel on the basis of pairvi report has not disputed the fact that no injury is attributed to the present petitioner.

5. Adjourned to 05.05.2025

6. Needful be done well before the date fixed with an advance copy to the counsel opposite.

7. In the meanwhile, the petitioner is hereby directed to join investigation within seven days from today and in the event of his arrest, he is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS.”

6. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 08.04.2025 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 08.04.2025 is hereby confirmed, subject to



conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; she will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

7. The petition stands allowed.
