1. In the present petition, the prayer of the petitioners is for directing the respondent-Board to issue mark sheet to the petitioners for the Classes which they have admittedly passed.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that due to the certain facts which have been mentioned in the petition, the mark-sheet of the petitioners for 8th, 10th and 12th as the case may be, have been taken away from the petitioners by a person, namely, Permanand in a deceitful manner and the situation is such that the petitioner does not have the record of passing of the required examinations.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have approached the respondent-School for issuing of the duplicate mark sheets through their representation dated 13.02.2025 (Annexure P-3) which request is not being considered and accepted, hence, the respondents be



directed to decide the said representation in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

4. Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Parvinder Chauhan, Senior Advocate with Ms. Vasundhra Asija, Advocate, who are present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and submits that in case, the representation dated 13.02.2025 (Annexure P-3) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
