1. Present petition has been filed under Section 401 Cr.PC impugning the judgment dated 06.04.2023 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Pathankot, whereby the appeal of the petitioner has been dismissed and vide judgment dated 08.03.2017 passed by learned JMIC, Pathankot, the accused-respondents No.2 to 4 have been acquitted for the offence under Sections 498-A and 406 read with Section 34 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been settled between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court vide settlement agreement dated 20.01.2025 in CRR(F)-455-2016. In view of the said development, learned counsel wishes to withdraw the present petition.
