SANJAY VASHISTH. J.(Oral)

1. Present petition under Section 528 of BNSS, has been filed seeking permission to go abroad, as the petitioner has to go for his medical treatment/appointment scheduled for 06.08.2025 and for extension of medical certificate and entitlements by the employer, however, the petitioner is facing trial before the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Payal in FIR No.65 dated 21.05.2019, under Sections 323, 341, 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Doraha, Police District Khanna, Police Commissionerate Ludhiana, titled as "State Vs. Manjot Singh".
2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that a similar prayer has already been addressed by petitioner by moving an application dated 14.07.2025 (Annexure P-6) before the trial Court but uptill now no decision has been taken in the said application.
3. Counsel further informs that proceedings for consideration of the

application is fixed for today itself before the learned trial Court.

4. Urgency to the petitioner is that medical treatment/appointment is scheduled for 06.08.2025 and in case petitioner is not permitted to join the said medical treatment/appointment, he would suffer a big loss.

5. In view of the submissions addressed by the petitioner and having noticed that a similar application dated 14.07.2025 is already scheduled for its consideration for today itself before the learned trial Court, wherein, the prosecution/State has already given its no objection for granting permission (as informed by petitioner's counsel during hearing), a direction is issued to the concerned learned trial Court to decide the application today itself or maximum by tomorrow in the first session of the day by considering the request of petitioner in its entirety.

6. Let copy of the order be uploaded just now, so that same be produced before the learned Magistrate by the trial Court's counsel.

7. Accordingly with the aforementioned direction, present petition stands disposed of.
