1. This petition has been preferred by the petitioner, under Section 528 BNSS, 2023, for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus*, directing the official respondents to call the status of the complaint dated 20.04.2025 (Annexures P-1 to P-3) or to register a FIR against respondent No.5.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner has preferred the representation(s)/complaint(s) dated 20.04.2025 (Annexures P-1 to P-3) to respondents No.2 to 4, but no action has been taken so far. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if directions are issued to respondent No. 4-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib, to look into his representation/complaint and take appropriate steps at the earliest.
3. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and carefully perused the material available on record.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and the limited prayer made by the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muksar Sahib, to consider and decide the representation/ complaint dated 20.04.2025 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner in accordance with law.
