**DEEPAK GUPTA, J. (ORAL)**

In civil suit bearing CIS No.CS/2330/2013 (CNR No.PBFDA0-000064-2012) titled as 'Harwinder Singh v. Kulwant Singh' order dated 21.09.2017 was passed by the trial Court, dismissing an application under Order VI Rule 17 CPC, which was assailed by the defendant of the case by filing CR-6431-2017.

In the aforesaid suit, another order dated 14.03.2019 was passed by the trial Court, declining the request of the defendant to direct the plaintiff to give his specimen voice sample for the purpose of comparison. Against that order, defendant approached this Court by filing CR-5531-2019.



Today learned counsel for the respondent-plaintiff has placed on record copy of the judgment dated 07.03.2020 of the trial Court revealing that main suit itself has since been decided.

As such, both the revisions have been rendered as infructuous.
