1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Section 12 read with Section 2-A of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 along with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, is for taking action against the respondent for willfully and deliberately disobeying order (Annexure P-1) dated 24.01.2020 in CWP No.1870 of 2020.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the learned State Counsel has furnished copy of order dated 25.11.2020 passed by the respondent in compliance of order (Annexure P-1) dated 24.01.2020 in CWP No.1870 of 2020 and in view thereof, he does not wish to pursue the contempt petition any further and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated 25.11.2020, by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

4. The same is not opposed by learned State Counsel.

5. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner the contempt petition is ***dismissed as withdrawn*** with the liberty, as prayed for.
