Present petition has been instituted seeking quashing of FIR No.253 dated 6.10.2018 under Section 420 IPC at Police station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur and subsequent judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 20.1.2024 passed by learned ACJM, Sangrur whereby the petitioners have been held guilty and convicted for the offence under Section 420 IPC and they have been sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for two years besides payment of fine of ₹ 500/-.

2. Now it is submitted that the matter has been compromised with the complainant but it has been admitted that once criminal complaint

bearing No.CRA-93-2024 is pending in the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur. However, the offence under Section 420 IPC is compoundable and the petitioner has remedy to approach the appellate Court for compounding of the offence instead of approaching this Court by invoking jurisdiction under Section 528 of BNSS.

3. At this stage, counsel for the petitioner submits that he withdraws the present petition but he may be granted liberty to approach the Appellate Court for getting the offence compounded and the same is accepted.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
