The petitioner has filed the instant revision petition challenging the order dated 18.10.2022 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate-cum-Juvenile Justice Board Rupnagar, whereby the application filed by the petitioner for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.176 dated 17.09.2022 registered under Section 376 of IPC, Sections 67-A & 67-B of I.T. Act and Sections 6 & 14 of POCSO Act at Police Station City Rupnagar, District Rupnagar, has been dismissed and order dated 01.03.2023 passed by learned Sessions Judge, Rupnagar, whereby an appeal filed by the petitioner against the order dated 18.10.2022, has been dismissed.
