1. Present petition has been filed praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case bearing DDR/GD No.040, dated 12.11.2024, under Sections 118(1), 115(2), 191 of BNS (Sections 30, 190 of BNS registered at Police Station Sadar Faridkot and offence under Section 118(2) of BNS added later on vide DDR No.14 dated 13.01.2025) in case FIR No.217, dated 12.11.2024, under Sections 333, 115(2), 118(1), 3(5) of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot.

2. Vide order dated 03.02.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join the investigation.



3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that pursuant to order dated 03.02.2025, the petitioners have joined the investigation and as such their interim bail may be made absolute.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurbaksh Singh, has affirmed the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no more required for further investigation.

5. In view of the above, interim order dated 03.02.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023.

6. Petition stands allowed.
