SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE

This Public Interest Litigation essentially raises the alleged public cause that despite respondents No.6, 7 and 8 indulging in financial irregularities by misusing the power vested in them, no action has been taken by respondents No.2, 3 and 4, before whom the complaints have been made.

2. For the purpose of inquiring into the complaints of financial nature against persons holding civil posts in the State, the Lokpal organization has been constituted, which is a statutory Body constituted under the Punjab



Lokpal Act, 1996, where detailed procedure has been laid down for accepting, considering and disposal of such complaints.

3. The petitioner has not availed the remedy under the Punjab Lokpal Act, 1996. He is free to avail the said remedy.

4. Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
