Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that contempt proceedings be initiated against the respondent for not complying the order dated 22.11.2022 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-26707-2022 titled as “Dr. Piush Kumar vs. Union of India and others”, vide which direction was issued to respondent No.5 therein to decide the representation dated 15.7.2022 (Annexure P-8 therein) within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Compliance Report dated 01.8.2023 by way of affidavit of Shri Rajiv Rattan, Director, Higher Education, Haryana, Panchkula has already been filed in the Registry, which is annexed on the file. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof is supplied to learned



counsel for the petitioner(s). Registry to tag/paginate the same at appropriate place in the paper-book.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that s per the said Compliance Report dated 01.8.2023, the necessary compliance has been made; thus, no cause survives in the present petition.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition, the same is **disposed of** accordingly.

The petitioner would be at liberty to challenge the aforesaid Speaking Order as per law.

Rule stands discharged.
