The prayer in the petition under Section 482 Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.06 dated 07.03.2025 registered under Sections 120-B, 420 IPC and Section 13 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 registered at P.S. Anti Corruption Bureau, District Gurugram, Haryana.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 13.05.2025 **passed** by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel has filed Status report by way of an affidavit of Mr. Arjun Dev, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, SV & Anti Corruption Bureau, Gurugram in the court today, which is taken on record and on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation
