1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. challenging the impugned order dated 16.05.2017 (Annexure P-18) passed by the learned CJJD-cum-JMIC, Anandpur Sahib vide which the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed offender in FIR No.37 dated 22.04.2016 registered at Police Station Nurpur Bedi, District Rupnagar under Sections 406, 498-A IPC.
2. Notice of motion in the present case was issued on 26.03.2018 and proceedings before the trial Court were stayed.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been settled between the parties vide compromise deed dated 05.12.2024.
4. Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has affirmed the factum of compromise and learned counsel for parties jointly stated that a petition bearing CRM-M-62135-2024 titled as *Bajinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and*



another seeking quashing of aforesaid FIR on the basis of said compromise deed dated 05.12.2024 has also been filed before this Court.

4. In this view of the matter, the impugned order dated 16.05.2017 (Annexure P-18) is set aside, subject to payment of costs of Rs.1.5 lakhs to be deposited by the petitioner with Punjab State Legal Services Authority within a period of one month from today.

5. With the aforesaid observation, the instant petition stands disposed of.
