Learned State counsel on instructions from Mr. Sushil Mangla, BDPO Shahzadpur submits that though no speaking orders have been passed, however, the petitioners have not been found entitled for allotment of 100 square yards plots.

In such circumstances, the respondents are directed to afford opportunity of hearing to the petitioners on Monday i.e. 24.02.2025 at 11:00 am in the office of BDPO, Shahzadpur and the Committee shall offer hearing to the petitioners and pass separate speaking orders with respect to the petitioners on their claim towards 100 square yards plots. Learned State counsel further assures that the speaking orders shall be passed within a period of two weeks of the date of hearing and a copy thereof shall be furnished to the petitioner within one week thereafter.

In view of the aforesaid, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.

Rule discharged.

However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioners would be at liberty to seek revival of the contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned Officer would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioners towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
