1. This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking quashing of FIR No.340 dated 29.10.2022 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 323/324/506/34 of IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Division-B, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom in view of the compromise dated 21.05.2024 (Annexure P-2).

2. Vide order dated 20.11.2024 passed by the Coordinate Bench, parties were directed to appear before the concerned trial Court for recording of their statements with regard to the compromise.

3. In compliance of the above order, a report has been received from the concerned jurisdictional Court that the compromise between the parties is genuine and arrived at without any pressure or coercion from anyone.

4. Learned counsel for respondent No.2 confirms the factum of the compromise having been effected between the parties and states that respondent No.2 has no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question.

5. Learned State counsel states that no other FIR has been registered against the petitioner and he has no known criminal antecedents.

6. In that view of the matter, even if this case is taken to its logical conclusion, it would only be an exercise in futility as the parties have already settled their differences. Therefore, no purpose would be served in wasting the time and resources of the State in pursuing this case to its preordained end. It would, therefore, be better to give a quietus to the issue at this stage.

7. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and FIR No.340 dated 29.10.2022 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 323/324/506/34 of IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Division-B, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom shall stand quashed, qua the petitioner.
