SURYA PARTAP SINGH, J. (Oral):

1. This is a petition for anticipatory bail filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023, in a case arising out of FIR No.113 dated 27.05.2025 under Sections 333, 329(3), 324(4), 351(3) of BNS 2023, Police Station City Rajpura, District Patiala.

2. Vide order dated 21.07.2025, the petitioner was admitted to interim anticipatory bail, subject to the condition of furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer.

3. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that in compliance with above mentioned order, dated 21.07.2025, the petitioner has already joined investigation.

4. In view of abovementioned contention, on the instructions of ASI Balbir Singh, Police Station City Rajpura, who is present in the Court, learned



State Counsel has stated that in compliance with the order dated 21.07.2025, the petitioner has joined investigation. He has further stated that the presence of petitioner is not required for the investigation of the present case.
