Through the instant fourth petition, the petitioner craves for indulgence of this Court for his being enlarged on 'regular bail', in case FIR No.228, dated 09.10.2023, under Sections 18 the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985, (Sections 25 and 29 of the NDPS Act, and Sections 148 and 149 of IPC, added later on), registered at Police Station Division No.8, Jalandhar.

2. On an advance notice, learned State counsel, has caused appearance and filed a custody certificate *qua* the petitioner today in court, which is taken on record, with a copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. The last petition, seeking the same relief was dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 13.11.2024 (Annexure P-5), and now after

only two months, without awaiting the further progress in the trial, instant petition has been filed. Therefore, this Court finds no ground to entertain the instant petition, which is consequently, **dismissed**.
