The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 to 4 to consider and act upon the complaint registered on 06.09.2024 (Annexure P-2) and legal notice dated 21.10.2024 (Annexure P-6) sent by the petitioner to the official respondents to register an FIR.

The learned State counsel, at the very outset, submits that the veracity of the allegations made by the petitioner in her legal notice (Annexure P-6) have been thoroughly gone into by the jurisdictional police authorities and after thorough investigation, her complaint was ordered to be consigned to record.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to invoke alternative appropriate remedy on the same cause of action in accordance with law for redressal of grievances raised in the present petition.
