Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of BNSS for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.228 dated 27.12.2024 under Sections 3, 5, 8 of Cow Slaughter Act, 1955 and Section 325 of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Division No.8, District Jalandhar, Police Commissionerate.
