HARSH BUNGER, J. (ORAL)

1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 24.04.2025 (Anexure P-3), passed by learned Financial Commissioner, Haryana in revision petition (ROR-82/2024-25), filed by respondent No. 5 herein (Raghbir Singh).

1.1 A further prayer has been made for directing respondents No. 1 and 2 to decide the review application bearing No. 82 of 2024-25 (Annexure P-4), filed by petitioner in revision petition (ROR-82/2024-25).

2. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that he restricts his prayer for directing respondent No. 2 (Additional Chief Secretary-cum-Financial Commissioner, Haryana) to decide the review application bearing No. 82 of 2024-25, filed by the petitioner in revision petition (ROR-82/2024-25), in a time bound manner.

3. In pursuance of advance copy of petition having been served upon respondents No. 1 to 4, Mr. Rajneesh Chadwal, AAG Haryana appears and on instructions from Mr. Amit Bhardwaj, District Attorney to Chief Secretary Office, Haryana, submits that the incumbent Financial Commissioner has recently retired and a new officer is likely to join shortly within a period of ten days and the review application filed by the petitioner in revision petition would be considered and decided by the new officer within a period of three weeks from the date he assumes the charge of office.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid stand taken by learned State counsel, the instant civil writ petition stands disposed of.
5. Pending applications(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
