[1]. By way of present revision petition, challenge has been laid to an order dated 19.05.2025 passed by the learned Additional District Judge, Kaithal-cum-Executing Court whereby the execution preferred at the instance of petitioner-landowner while claiming himself to be co-sharer with the landowners those, who were granted benefit of enhanced compensation in terms of Award dated 01.10.1997 passed by the Reference Court, came to be declined.

[2]. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and gone through the paper book.

[3]. Perusal of record shows that the learned Executing Court dismissed the execution filed at the instance of petitioner/landowner for the reason that he was neither a party/claimant arrayed in the reference petition filed under Section 18 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 resulted into passing of Award dated 01.10.1997 nor there was any Award passed in his favour under Section 28-A of the said Act, thus the execution filed at his instance was not maintainable.

[4]. Without going into the aspect that the petitioner being co-sharer of the joint khewat along with landowners those who assailed the original award dated 26.02.1992 passed by the Land Acquisition Collector and upon reference an Award dated 01.10.1997 was passed in their favour, based upon filed execution without there being any Award under Sections 18 or 28-A of the Act in his favour, the same having been preferred by the petitioner only on 01.02.2024, as such being barred by limitation cannot be entertained, therefore, no merit can be found in the present revision and consequently, the same is dismissed.
