The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *certiorari* quashing the illegal actions of the respondents whereby they have excessively deducted/recovered the commuted pension from petitioners no.1 to 3 beyond 136 installments and similarly recovered excessive commuted pension beyond 140 installments from petitioner no.4.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that at this stage, the petitioners will be satisfied in case they are permitted to make a fresh representation before the respondents raising the grievance as has been raised in this petition, and the same may be ordered to be decided within a specified period

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Rohit Arya, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State. Ms. Anu Sandhu, Advocate for Mr. H.S. Oberoi, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent no.4 and submits

that in case any such representation is filed by the petitioner, the same will be decided by respondent no.4 expeditiously.

5. In view thereof, without going into the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to file a representation before the respondents within a period of two weeks from today. In case any such representation is filed by the petitioners, the same shall be decided by respondent no.4-Accountant General (A&E), by passing a speaking order thereupon in accordance with law, within a period of three months of receiving the representation.

6. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioners.
