1. The present contempt petition has been filed for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order dated 25.02.2022 passed by this Court in COCP-351-2022.

2. This Court had issued the following directions in COCP-351-2022, vide its order dated 25.02.2022:-

*“Keeping in view the facts of the case, it is considered appropriate to request the competent authority to comply with the order dated 17.10.2018, positively within a period of one month, from today. With these observations, the present petition is disposed of.”*
