The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of *Certiorari*, for setting aside the orders dated 18.11.2023 (Annexure P-1), 25.07.2024 (Annexure P-2) and 18.11.2024 (Annexure P-3) passed by learned Deputy Collector, Hisar, learned Divisional Canal Officer, Hisar and learned Superintending Canal Officer, Hisar, respectively.
