**HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)**

1. Learned counsel for the respondent, on instructions, from Mr. Jai Kumar (IFS), Deputy Conservator of Forests, Karnal, submits that the arrears payable to the petitioner towards regular pay scale from 38 months prior to the date of actual regularization along with other benefits shall be released in his favour, within a period of 03 weeks from today.

2. In view of the aforesaid undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not want to press the present petition.

3. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed being not pressed. Rule stands discharged.

4. However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring

concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
