**ANIL KSHETARPAL, J. (Oral)**

1. With the consent of learned counsel for the parties, two connected first appeals against two different but connected orders passed by the Family Court shall stand disposed of by this order.

2. The wife of the respondent filed a joint application under Section 24 read with Section 26 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, for grant of maintenance *pendente lite* for herself and her child. The Family Court has only considered the application on behalf of the appellant but failed to decide the request of the son for grant of maintenance.



3. Consequently, the Family Court is directed to consider that aspect qua the child.
4. With these observations, both the appeals are disposed of.
5. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
