1. Affidavit of respondent-Ranbir Singh Hooda, Principal, Skill Development and Industrial Training Department, Rohtak has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record.

2. On the asking of the Court, Sh. Naveen Gupta, Principal Accountant General, Haryana is ordered to be impleaded as party respondent No.2.

Registry is directed to make the necessary amendment in the memo of parties.

3. Notice to newly added respondent No.2.

4. Mr. H.S. Oberoi, Advocate, who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of newly added respondent No.2 and submits that the financial benefits payable to the petitioner have been released.

5. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not intend to press the present petition.

6. Dismissed as not pressed.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to raise his grievance regarding unsatisfied claim, if any, by filing representation before the quarter concerned within a period of two weeks from today, which shall be dealt with, as per law, within a period of four weeks thereafter from the date of its receipt by passing a speaking order thereupon, which shall be conveyed to the petitioner within a period of two weeks thereafter and in case of any delay on the part of respondent(s), the officer(s) concerned would be liable to pay costs of Rs. 50,000/- to the petitioner from his / her own pocket.
